

## Representative Matters

- Lead environmental counsel in lease of approximately 200 service stations.
- Received a \$40 million judgment against the Department of Defense in a CERCLA cost recovery action on a unique theory of liability.
- Lead counsel on environmental issues for construction of Project CityCenter in Las Vegas — the largest privately funded construction project in the world.
- Lead Counsel for Huffy, Inc. in San Gabriel Valley Superfund Site, which resulted in the largest Superfund settlement in the country at that time.
